

HOW TO COME TO SERRES FROM THE AIRPORT OF THESSALONIKI

Take the bus “**01X AIRPORT - INTERCITY BUS TERMINAL (VIA CITY CENTRE)**”.

It runs 2-3 buses per hour. You may [check the schedule here](#)

The ticket costs 2 euro.

You can buy from the ticket counter, next to the bus stop, before entering the bus.

There must be also a vending machine.

When you enter the bus, you must validate your ticket.

Depending on the time and the traffic in the city centre, the route takes 45-60 minutes.

The Intercity Bus Terminal is the terminal station (no need to worry for the bus stop you will get off).

In the Intercity Bus Terminal, there are different ticket counters for each destination. Find the ticket counter to Serres (in Greek: ΣΕΡΡΕΣ).

The ticket costs 15 euro (I think).

Ask the platform that the bus departs, because the announcements are in Greek only.

The buses run on the following schedule:

- Monday to Friday: 07:00 08:00 09:00 10:00 11:00 12:00 13:00 14:00 15:00 16:00 17:00 18:00 19:00 20:00 21:00 22:00
- Saturday: 08:00 09:00 10:00 11:00 12:00 13:00 14:00 15:00 16:00 17:00 18:00 19:00 20:00 21:00 22:00
- Sunday & Holidays: 08:00 09:00 10:00 11:00 12:00 13:00 14:00 15:00 16:00 17:00 18:00 19:00 20:00 21:00 22:00

* last bus at 22:00; if you do not catch it, take a taxi or stay in Thessaloniki

The trip takes almost 1:30 h.

When you arrive at Serres, you can take a taxi, it will cost you 5 – 7 euro, depending on your accommodation location.

Perhaps a surcharge for luggage is applied, like 0.5 euro per piece of luggage.
